Initially, Jump, Jive & Wail was simply a Jazz Concert held at the Maritime Center. Due to the overwhelming success its first year, the event was repeated the following year for a significantly larger crowd. It became apparent that there was "demand" for the performance of these outstanding musicians, so additional resources were put behind the planning and execution. By year 4, the event had clearly outgrown the Maritime Center and was relocated to the current setting at the Visitor's Center (Bus Shed).

ASGT is a semi-formal adult event that is an off-shoot of the family oriented Jump, Jive and Wail. It provides a means for the community to support the School of the Arts music program and have fun at the same time. The SOA Jazz Band performs a mix of big band tunes of yesteryear and more contemporary jazz tunes. The band plays as the audience enjoys outstanding food and beverages.

Also while folks are enjoying the great jazz music, they are invited to peruse the myriad of items on display at the silent auction. Items have ranged from jewelry and unique home décor pieces to certificates for fine restaurants, travel and more.
